It is a great pleasure to inform you that since the Asian College of Neuropsychopharmacology (AsCNP) was founded in October 2008, the founding committee has agreed to have its first biannual meeting in Kyoto, Japan, the second one in Korea, and the third one in China.

Mental disorders including suicide are global public health problems, particularly in Asia where suicide is highly prevalent in many countries with large populations. Since the discovery of chlorpromazine and imipramine, psychoneuropharmacology has been advanced in the last half century, and a large number of psychotropic drugs have been developed. However these mental disorders have been under-diagnosed and under-treated in Asian countries. Therefore, there is a need for education and research collaboration in both basic and clinical neuropsychopharmacology in Asia.

The theme for the first AsCNP Kyoto meeting is "New Asian Global Collaboration on Neuropsychopharmacology" in order to encourage both basic and clinical collaborative research and education in Asia. This meeting will be concurrently held with two annual meetings of the Japanese Society of Neuropsychopharmacology (JSNP) and the Japanese Society of Clinical Neuropsychopharmacology (JSCNP). Two symposia will be jointly held with those meetings, and we are expecting that it will be a great opportunity for Asian researchers to exchange and discuss the latest knowledge and information on this field.

Kyoto is one of the most famous and attractive historical cities in Japan, because it has a number of sightseeing places registered as world heritage sites by UNESCO; moreover, the time of the meeting would be the best season for viewing autumn colored leaves. Do take the opportunity of combining the visit for the meeting with a few extra days of sightseeing.
